**KAREN HOLDEN, UW Madison:** Professor of Consumer Science and Public Affairs. Was Associate Director of the Robert M. La Follette School of Public Affairs 2005-2007 and 1995-1998. Faculty member since 1989. Associate Dean for Research and Graduate Education, School of Human Ecology (2003-05). Teaching focus on risk management; research focus on retirement security, widowhood, social security, and pensions. PhD in Economics with focus on Demography from the University of Pennsylvania. UIA Board member since 1997. Term expires 2009.

**WILLIAM MAAS, UW Stevens Point:** Assistant Professor of Accounting and Business Law at UW Stevens Point. He received his BBA and MS degrees from the UW Whitewater and his JD degree from Northern Illinois University. He is licensed as both a CPA and an Attorney. He is a member of the State Bar of Wisconsin, Institute of Management Accountants and Portage County Assn. of Certified Public Accountants. UIA Board since 2007. Term expires 2009.

Received undergraduate degree from UW Stevens Point in Philosophy and Psychology and graduate degree from Iowa in Business Leadership. Joined UIA Board in 2008. Term expires 2010.

**DIANNE MORRISON, UW La Crosse:** Lecturer in the Finance Department. Teaches Principles of Financial Management course, Personal Finance, and Real Estate Finance. Former business owner and serves on the Board of Directors for Advantage Credit Union.
